

Schedule of Health Care Fees (effective 1 May 2019)

This document outlines what MAPFRE Middlesea plc considers to be Reasonable fees payable to Health Care Professionals under the terms of its Health Insurance Policies. The amounts indicated in this document are the maximum benefits payable by MAPFRE Middlesea plc for surgical procedures including pre-and post-operative care during in-patient stay and management of common complications, always subject to the terms and conditions, limitations and exclusions of the applicable insurance policy.

Benefits are payable for a maximum of 3 procedures performed at the same time and calculated in the following way:
2 procedures- 125 percent of the benefit for the higher graded procedure;
3 procedures- 140 percent of the benefit for the higher graded procedure.

The benefits are not payable to surgical assistants.
